The Neuroscience Program at Skidmore College invites applications for a two-year Visiting Assistant Professor position in Neuroscience to begin Fall 2025. This position will serve to strengthen the interdisciplinary Neuroscience Program at Skidmore College. The teaching-load averages nine contact hours per semester. This position covers such courses as Introductory Neuroscience with lab and intermediate- or upper-level courses in the candidate's subspecialty; ideally, we seek to supplement our current faculty offerings by hiring someone who brings new expertise and course topics to our curriculum.

Candidates must be firmly committed to undergraduate education. Skidmore has made strong advances in its goal of increasing diversity among its faculty and student bodies; we request that applicants include information in their cover letter and/or teaching statement about how they will inclusively teach a diverse population of students.
